IMPORT DATABASE RECORDS
To import inspector information into the database, download the template first. Once you have inserted your records into the template, save the file to your desktop (do not change the file name of the template) and click the "Upload New Inspectors" link below. This will prompt you for a file location of your template. Once uploaded, CUSEC will insert the records into the database.
